TRAFFIC DEVELOPMENT

The total number of passengers flown in May 2010 was 1,185,373 compared to 946,082 last year, an increase of 239,291 passengers (25%).

Compared to the same period last year:

- ▲ Total passenger traffic (RPK) increased by 37 %
- ▲ Total capacity (ASK) increased by 38 %
- ▲ The load factor was 77 %, which is equivalent to last year

The increase in passenger traffic, production and passengers is related to the Group's expansion in established markets and to the introduction of new routes from June 2009 to May 2010, as well as adjustments to production capacity.

Compared to the same period last year the Group has a significantly larger operation across all three Scandinavian countries.

The average flying distance for the Group increased by 5 % in May compared to the same period last year.

PASSENGER REVENUES

The yield is estimated at 0.51 for the period (-14 %). The y.o.y. yield development reflects an adjusted route portfolio with 5 % longer sector length and the introduction 12 new 737-800 aircraft with higher capacity and lower unit cost since May 2009.
